Prior experience working with individuals on the autism spectrum, is preferred.

The NFAR Works Instructional Assistant will be responsible for providing:

- Direct instruction to Works program participants, in small group settings and 1:1
- Provide guidance and encouragement to program participants, helping them to develop good problem-solving skills.
- Document daily activities and track progress and task completion
- Support creation of program material and teaching aides
- Maintains a safe, organized work environment, which supports participants' learning, collaboration and choice.

Should have:

- Minimum two (2) year's work experience
- Basic understanding of individuals with autism with demonstrated cultural awareness and sensitivity to cognitive-socio diversity
- Must be familiar with current business operating systems, software, and programs (i.e. Microsoft Office, to include Word, Excel, PowerPoint, etc.) and a willingness to learn.
