The first of its kind in San Diego, the conference offers educators around the county an opportunity to share and learn about programs and techniques being used in classrooms to support students with autism.

The Forum focuses on strategies being used to strengthen communication and social skills. Educators (representing students from elementary to high school age) will be presenting on the following topics: video modeling techniques, social interest clubs, life skills training, integrated play groups and more. Special guest speakers include SD Unified School District's Director of Special Education Joe Fulcher, and SDSU Masters of Education Professors Dr. Laura Hall and Dr. Bonnie Kraemer, among others.
