Reach Environment: Classroom

Description of Impact: Last year I developed a proposal to develop an inclusion program at my school and it flourished! My students have developed friendships with the general education students and in return the general education students are beginning to socialize with my students. This year, I am writing a proposal to develop a coffee / snack cart at my school to help foster the relationship between my students and the staff at my school. As a new special education program to the district, the general population at my school has very little experience with special day class students. I can tell that they want to have a relationship with my students but they do not quite know how. Through the development of a coffee / snack cart, the staff will have the opportunity to interact with my students on a weekly basis and foster those important interactions.
